COLLEGE TEACHING EXPERIENCE

Adjunct Lecturer, The Pennsylvania State University 2023-present

- Direct and design the new experimental music group Other Arts Ensemble. Other Arts is an open-insturmentation ensemble dedicated to the hands-on on work of experimental music as embodied in the work of Sun Ra, Pauline Oliveros, Christian Wolff, the AACM and others. Students work in this ensemble as full collaborators on artistic, arrangingt, rehearing, and performing decisions. Other Arts has performed works by Julius Eastman, Karlheinz Stockhausen, Sarah Hennies, Sun Ra, Brian Eno, and more.
- Co-design and teach Digital Audio Fundamentals, a class that introduces students to the basics of recording, mixing, and mastering audio, as well as making original electronic music through synthesis and sampling. Altered the existing syllabus to be more hands-on, to work like a studio art class where students can regularly engage with the material in a collaborative and supportive setting.
- Design and teach a 400/500 level special topics course titled Organizing Sound: Getting (and Keeping) the Band Together in 20th and 21st Century Music. This course looks at various non-institutional musical organizations throughout the last 100 years with a goal of understanding how these artists thought about the collaborative social landscape they needed to make their music. The course is both an alternative history that focuses on groups rather than individuals, and also an inspirational template for students who will soon be leaving the university and needing to make their own collaborative decisions for their musical lives.

- Teach percussion lessons for non-major students, including orchestral and rudimental snare drum technique, reading skills, two- and four-mallet keyboard technique and repertoire, rock, jazz, soul, and latin styles on drum set, and hand percussion.
